600 yard Any-Any Mid Range

DATES: Sunday May 10, Saturday June 13, Sunday July 12 and Sunday October 11.

Time and Squadding will begin at 8:15 am. Squadding closes and match begins at 9 am. BE ON TIME!

PRACTICE 600 any-any: Watch your email and the CRC website for 600 yard practices during the months of January – April. I will try to hold one practice per month. Weather and range availability permitting. Members are free and guests \$5.00.

LOCATION/LODGING: Colorado Rifle Club, 76099 East 96th Ave. Byers, Co 80103. The Range is located about 8 miles east of Byers on US HWY 36, then about 9 miles North on the Leader Road (52N), then one mile west on 96th Ave to the Range gate, then one mile North to the Ranges. See <u>www.crci.org</u> click on "Facilities" tab for map and also a list of nearby lodging in Byers and Bennett, Colorado.

ENTRY CARD: Entries will be filled out the morning of the match. You can pay the match fees at this time also. *No advanced entries will be accepted or necessary this year.*

MATCH FEE'S: <u>Cash only!</u> Fees: \$25.00 for nonmembers, \$20.00 for seniors and CRC members, \$10 for juniors. \$4.50 is for NRA Fees and \$5.00 for CRC range fees. <u>Entry fees must be paid in cash.</u> Exact change is appreciated. Please no checks, credit cards or bit coin.

<u>RULES</u>: Current NRA High-Power Rifle Rules will govern this tournament. Any safe ammunition is allowed. Tracer/Incendiary Ammunition is not allowed.

<u>CLASSIFICATIONS</u>: NRA Mid Range classifications will be used. There will be awards for each class unless there are fewer than 5 entries in that class, in which case those entries may be combined into the next higher classification. Unclassified competitors will compete as Masters. <u>High Masters will</u> <u>compete for Aggregate Match winner only.</u>

CATEGORIES: There will be three categories for these tournaments:

1. ANY RIFLE / ANY SIGHT Palma

2. F CLASS, Open and TR, .35 caliber or less, any sights, rests permitted from the prone position. F class will fire as an autonomous class with awards based on 5 or more competitors for one place award. Additional awards for each 5 competitors.

3. AR Tactical Category: see NRA rules. If less than 5 shooters elect this category, they will shoot with Palma.

4. Additional categories may be created at the discretion of the Match Director based upon entries.

COURSE OF FIRE: There will be three (3) matches of 20 shots for record with <u>unlimited sighters</u> in the first match and <u>2 sighters</u> in match 2 and 3 in a time limit of 20 minutes. There will also be an aggregate match (total of the matches 1, 2 and 3).

AWARD SCHEDULE: The entry fees (minus \$4.50 NRA fees and \$5.00 CRC range fee) are to be returned to the competitors in the form of awards. The value of the awards depends on the number of shooters.

<u>COMPETITOR DUTIES</u>: Competitors will score and/or operate targets if not shooting. Failure to serve your assigned detail (firing, scoring, and target duties) may result in disqualification for that match. There is the possibly we will score in the pits and run only 2 relays. This depends on number of competitors present.

TARGETS: NRA mid-range (MR-1) for the 600 yard matches, F Class targets are used for F Class.

WEATHER CANCELLATION: Should weather be a factor, competitors will be notified by email NLT 2000 hours the night before a match. If I don't have your email address, I can't communicate information to you. Also check the CRC website for cancellations.

Palma Long Range or 1k yard matches are scheduled on the <u>same weekend</u> as the 600 AA this year. See <u>www.crci.org</u> for dates and entry information for 1k/Palma matches.
