**PRACTICE 600 any-any:** Watch your email and the CRC website for 600 yard practices during the months of January – March. I will try to hold one practice per month. Weather and range availability permitting. Members are free and guests \$5.00.

**LOCATION/LODGING:** Colorado Rifle Club, 76099 East 96th Ave. Byers, Co 80103. The Range is located about 8 miles east of Byers on US HWY 36, then about 9 miles North on the Leader Road (52N), then one mile west on 96th Ave to the Range gate, then one mile North to the Ranges. **ENTRY CARD**: Entries will be filled out the morning of the match. You can pay the match fees at this time also. **No advanced entries are necessary again this year.** 

**MATCH FEE'S:** <u>Cash only!</u> Fees: \$15.00 for nonmembers, seniors and CRC members and \$10 for juniors. \$4.50 is for NRA Fees and the rest for CRC range fees. <u>Entry fees must be paid in cash.</u> Exact change is appreciated. Please no checks, credit cards or bit coin.

<u>RULES:</u> Current NRA High-Power Rifle Rules will govern this tournament. Any safe ammunition is allowed. Tracer/Incendiary/ Armor piercing ammunition is not allowed on any CRC range.

<u>CLASSIFICATIONS:</u> NRA Mid Range classifications will be used. No monetary awards will be given. Individuals will compete in one of the categories list below. If there are fewer than 5 entries in a category, those entries may be combined into the next higher classification/category. Unclassified competitors will compete as Masters. <u>High Masters will compete for Aggregate Match winner only.</u>

**COURSE OF FIRE:** There will be three (3) matches of 20 shots for record with **unlimited sighters** in a time limit of 25 minutes.

**COMPETITOR DUTIES:** Competitors will score and/or operate targets if not shooting. Failure to serve your assigned detail (firing, scoring, and target duties) may result in disqualification for that match.

<u>TARGETS</u>: NRA mid-range (MR-1) for the 600 yard matches, F Class targets are used for F Class.

<u>WEATHER CANCELLATION:</u> Should weather be a factor, competitors will be notified by email NLT 2000 hours the night before a match. If I don't have your email address, I can't communicate information to you. Also check the CRC website for cancellations.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: During the July 9 match we will shoot one match each at 300, 500 and 600 yds in preparation for the State Championship.
