Harold Anthony Stahl, 76, passed away on April 2, 2020. He was known to most of us as “Tony” and he joined the Colorado Rifle Club about 1989 and had badge number 271. His company Stahl Construction completed the covered firing lines for the Pistol, Smallbore and Schutzen Ranges in the early 1990s. He also completed many of the picnic shelters and supervised construction of several vaulted toilets for the facility. Harold served in the Army National Guard and was a high power and smallbore competitor. He also helped start the “Remembering the Brave” match at CRC. Tony was the first to volunteer no matter what was needed. He leaves a wife after 50 years of marriage and a huge legacy of all of the structures he built at the CRC facility. Tony you will be missed but not forgotten.

The string however continued as on June 6, 2020 I received a call from Nathan Jones No. 6558 who had found a very nice cased CZ Tactical Sports pistol on the range. Nathan just joined the club in the last few months and had taken the gun home with him. Fellow BOD member Bret Barnes got the call from the gun owner and then Bret notified me. I again made a few calls and put the two members together. Yet another happy ending.

These are very heartwarming stories and go a long way to renewing my faith in my fellow shooters. To my knowledge every missing firearm on the CRC facility has been reunited with its rightful owner. We want to thank these members. To these three members the BOD would like to excuse their work bond for 2020.
