

On Friday, October 16, 2020 The Tri-County Health department issued a Public Health Order “Limiting Gatherings and Alcohol Sales in Adams County”. That order went into effect on 9:00 PM Friday and will expire on Sunday, November 1, 2020. Click the link below to review this Health Order. A part of this order stated as follows: “Personal indoor gatherings are limited to no more than 5 individuals. Outdoor personal gatherings are limited to no more than 10 individuals”.

The Colorado Rifle Club does not fall under the “Personal Gathering “ category but under the “Regulated Gathering” category. The CRC is a non-critical business and participates in activities permitted pursuant to Appendix I: Indoor and Outdoor Events, and Appendix J; Recreation, of CDPHE Order 20-35. The Level 2 metrics in Order 20-35 allows up to 25 people per organized outdoor league sports. This is per Bay, firing line or Station. As always try to maintain the 6 foot social distancing , use masks when possible and wash or sanitize your hands often.

This Health Order does not affect the CRC activities however we need to follow the current Guide Lines.
