Range Location: The Colorado Rifle Club range is located at 76099 E. 96th Ave., Byers CO 80103.

LOCATION/LODGING: The Range is located about 8 miles east of Byers on US HWY 36, then about 9 miles North on the Leader Road (52N), then one mile west on 96th Ave to the Range gate, then one mile North to the Ranges. <u>Eligibility and Classification</u>: Open to all competitors; Governing body classification system used.

Match Fees: \$20 (\$15 for Juniors, Women)

Rules: All firing will be governed by NRA / CMP rules as appropriate.

Courses of Fire:

60 shot National Long Range with sighters.

(Standing 10 slow 200 yds. Sitting or Kneeling 10 rapid 200 yds. Prone 10 rapid 300 yds. Prone 10 slow 600 yds. Prone 20 slow 1000 yds.)

<u>80 shot Regional Course / Highpower Rifle Standard Course</u> with sighters. Shooters will start in position for the rapid-fire stages. (88 shots total)

<u>30 shot Presidents 100 Course</u> NO Sighting shots. Rapid-fire stages will start from a standing position.

Targets: SR (200 yd), SR-3 (300 yd), MR-1 (600 yd), LR (1000 yd)

<u>Rifles and Ammunition</u>: NRA Service Rifles 3.1, Any Rifle 3.2, Match Rifle 3.3; any safe ammunition, excluding tracer or incendiary.

CMP Service Rifles 4.1.1, 4.1.2, 4.1.3, 4.1.4, Match Rifle 4.1.5; any safe ammunition, excluding tracer or incendiary.

COMPETITOR DUTIES: Competitors will score and/or operate targets if not shooting. Failure to serve your assigned detail (firing, scoring, and target duties) may result in disqualification for that match.

<u>Awards</u>: Cash awards to the match winner, and by classification/special category.
