

¹LONG DISTANCE PRECISION RIFLE (LDPR) RANGE

In addition to the General Range Rules which apply everywhere on the CRC property, the following rules are specific to the Long Distance Precision Rifle (LDPR) Range area.

- 1 Shotguns and pistols are strictly prohibited on the LDPR Range.
- 1 Firing shall be conducted only from the LDPR firing line which is defined by colored survey markers and/or red paint on the north side of the berm/firing line.
- 2 Large calibers such as 408 Cheytac and 300 Norma are allowed but can only be shot 700 yards and further.
- 3 Cease fire periods shall be designated by an active strobe light and raised red flag. During a cease fire, rifles must be grounded with actions open, magazines removed, and an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) placed into open actions or placed in a rifle rack, actions open, muzzles up.
- 4 A post has been set on the firing line with a strobe light and flag holder. Before going down range switch on the strobe light and place the flag from the PVC holder into its bracket. Targets have been extended to one mile; therefore, cars may not always be visible from the firing line. It is your responsibility to verify everyone is behind the Firing Line before the cease fire is ended.
- 5 It is strictly forbidden to handle firearms or any range equipment during a cease fire. This includes moving firearms in any condition to/from a vehicle.
- 6 When changing shooting positions on props, rifle bolts must be in the rear position for bolt action rifles, and semi-auto rifles must have the safety in the "Safe" position.
- 7 Personal steel targets are strictly prohibited.
- 8 Properly dispose of paper targets and brass.
- 9 Personal paper targets are permitted on the 100-yard target boards only. No steel targets are utilized and will not be allowed at 100 yards.
- 10 All vehicle parking is to the south of the firing line and the wooden rail fence.
- 11 When downrange stay on designated roadways as the soil is very soft.
- 12 As noted in the general rules, be aware of wildlife and stray cattle.
