Vintage Sniper Matches are a team event consisting of 2 competitors per team. Pick up teams will be allowed. Please remember, this is a team event. Match officials will try to squad solo shooters together but they cannot guarantee you a partner.

DATE: Match will be held on Saturday, September 19th. Registration will begin about 0800 with a mandatory Competitor's briefing at 0830, followed by first shots down range shortly after the safety briefing.

LOCATION: Colorado Rifle Club High Power Rifle Range, 76099 East 96th Avenue, Byers, CO 80103. Byer is located about 45 miles east of Denver on I-70. The range is located about 8 miles east of Byers on U. S. 36, then about 9 miles north on Leader Road (52N). Then one mile west on 96th Ave. to the range gate, then one mile north to the ranges. (See map on information sheet or go to the club web site at www.crci.org. You can also Google or Bing this address for a map and aerial view. GPS also works on this address).

ELIGIBILITY: Any competitor 12 years of age or older and a citizen of the United States may enter this match. CMP rule 2.4.3 states that the age requirement may be waived by the match sponsor upon presentation of proof of the competitor's ability to handle a service rifle safely and complete the match course of fire. A notarized Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement must be on file with the Colorado Rifle Club. Forms and a Notary will be available at each match.

ENTRIES: This will be a team event consisting of 2 competitors per team. Team entries are to be made at the firing line the morning of the match. Pick up teams will be allowed however match officials cannot guarantee individuals with a shooting partner.

All competitors will be required to perform pit and scoring duties

Entries Limited To: 80 competitors (two relays of 40 competitors each) with post entries accepted for

squadding at the convenience of Match Officials provided no special squadding or relays are required.

Match Fees: \$20.00 per person for the one-day competition. **Make check or money order payable to: Colorado Rifle Club.**

LIABILITY WAIVER: An agreement of release and waiver of liability must be signed before the match starts. Copies will be available at the match or please go the CRC web site and print a copy.

RULES: The current Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Competition Rules will govern the conduct of this match.

CLASSIFICATION AND CATEGORIES: For Vintage Sniper, there are two categories, one for semi-automatic rifles and one for manually-operated rifles. If a team is firing both semi-automatic and manually-operated rifles, the team will be placed in the manually-operated category. No other classifications and categories in this match

AWARD SCHEDULE: Awards will be miniature metals from the CMP awarded to the top 3 teams Gold, Silver and Bronze from each category.

The CMP provides Certificates of Competition which will be presented to all competitors desiring them after the end of the awards ceremony. The results bulletin will be emailed after it is posted on the CMP web site (<http://www.odcmp.com/> click on Competition Tracker and the circle for Garand & Springfield Results) to all competitors who have email addresses on their score cards. The CMP Certificate of Competition can be snail mailed to competitors not staying for the awards ceremony, who so request (and if they choose to wait the four to eight weeks for the CMP to post the results, a paper copy of the results bulletin).

CMP RIFLE PURCHASE ELIGIBILITY: The CMP Certificate of Competition in one of these CMP matches meets the CMP requirement for proof of marksmanship participation for purchasing rifles from the CMP. Go to www.odcmp.com or call 888-267-0796 or 419-635-2141 for details.

SAFETY: Safety is paramount. Each shooter must provide eye and ear protection. Empty Chamber indicators must be used and may be borrowed for use at the match or purchased for \$1 each.

SHOOTERS BRIEFING: There will be a Mandatory pre-match shooters briefing at 8:30 to be sure that everyone understands the full meaning of rule 6.0, Vintage Sniper Rifle Team Match including the two categories, one for semi-automatic rifles and one for manually-operated rifles and Annex D, Vintage Sniper Rifle Firing Procedures from the CMP rule book. These rules should be read and understood before coming to the match. CMP Competition Rules are posted on the CMP web site at <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/CMPGamesRules.pdf> and may be downloaded from there without cost. Printed copies of the rules are available at a cost of \$3.00 each at the CMP E-Store.

COURSE OF FIRE: The Course of Fire is detailed in rule 6.0 and in Annex D.

DISTANCES TO BE FIRED: The CRC High Power range will be used to fire at 300 and 600 yards.

TARGETS: The Official SR-3 300 yard and MR 600 yard Military Targets will be used.

RIFLES: Each competitor should provide his or her rifle as stated in Table 7. Rule 2.7.4 states that Match Sponsors may, at their option, allow competitors to fire unlimited and special military rifles. These competitors will be recorded as firing out of competition (open individual category) and will not be eligible to win awards. This includes rifles from rule 4.0 and Table 7 without scopes.

AMMUNITION: Each shooter must bring their own safe ammunition.

LUNCH: There will not be a lunch break. There should be time to eat a snack/lunch while pulling targets in the pits or prior to the awards ceremony. Bring water to drink.

CAMPING: Overnight, self-contained camping is available on the range. Camper pads with electric hook ups are available for a fee of \$5 per night. Estimate the number of days that electric hook ups will be used and include that amount with your entry fee. Refunds will be made upon request for earlier than estimated departure. There is no charge for camping on the range in locations where electric hook ups are not available. Water is available at the caretaker house located on the range facility.
