

# Colorado Rifle Club Year 2021 Small Bore Prone Summer League

The Summer League consists of two league competitions fired simultaneously. The first will consist of 100 shot matches. The second will be a full 160 shot course. Both series are open to all competitors, both junior and senior. There are no entry requirements for either series except the desire to compete and have a good time.

There will be no classifications in the 100-shot series. Scores for each shooter will be handicapped with the handicap calculated using 80% of the difference between the shooters' average and a perfect score. Master classified shooters will receive no handicap.

For the dedicated shooter, the 160-shot series will follow traditional NRA rules with classifications. Senior shooters may fire any sights every week.

Shooters entering the 160-shot league will be automatically entered into the 100-shot match using the first target fired in the 100yd, 50m, and 50yd matches along with the Dewar match total. Competitors can opt for the course of fire each day of shooting.

## Course of fire - 100 Shot Match

Match 1. Dewar Course  
Match 2. 20 shots at 100 yards  
Match 3. 20 shots at 50 meters (reduced)  
Match 4. 20 shots at 50 yards  
Match 5. Aggregate of Matches 1-4

## Course of Fire – 160 Shot Match

Match 1. Dewar Course  
Match 2. 40 shots at 100 yards  
Match 3. 40 shots at 50 meters (reduced)  
Match 4. 40 shots at 50 yards  
Match 5. Aggregate of Matches 1-4

## Dates:

**The smallbore range at CRC has been reserved for the following league dates: May 1, May 15, May 30, June 19, June 27, July 10, August 8, August 29, and September 25. Shooters may use the range on these dates, following current applicable CRC and State of Colorado social distancing rules. If more than 10 shooters arrive, non-CRC members and/or the last to arrive must leave, or come back for a second relay after the others are complete. Shooters may also choose to shoot individually on their own schedule. In either case, email scores to Jennifer Obee for compilation. Updates to scores will be sent out on a regular basis via email.**

Time: All firing will start at 9:00 a.m. local time with squadding at 8:30 a.m.

Cost: Participation in the league is free. If using targets at CRC, the shooter must pay the \$1 per roll fee, and will need three rolls for 8 targets (bring exact change).

Awards: Match 5 each day; 1<sup>st</sup> Place for the 100-shot course. 1<sup>st</sup> Place for each class in the 160-shot course. A class will be established with a minimum of three shooters in a classification. Classifications with less than three shooters will be combined into the next higher class. **Competitors shooting in 4 or more of the daily matches will be eligible for League Awards at the end of the season.** No physical awards will be provided, just status and bragging rights.

Location: Official league shoots will be conducted at Colorado Rifle Club Smallbore Range

Competitors will score targets and the designated Range Officer will record the scores.
