LOCATION/LODGING: Colorado Rifle Club, 76099 East 96th Ave. Byers, Co 80103. The Range is located about 8 miles east of Byers on US HWY 36, then about 9 miles North on the Leader Road (52N), then one mile west on 96th Ave to the Range gate, then one mile North to the Ranges. WAIVER: All non-member competitors and guests MUST complete the CRC WAIVER. Friday, August 12: Practice at 300, 500, 600 yards. Arrive by 8:30 am.

Saturday, August 13 **NRA Registered**

All matches are slow fire, 2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.

Match 1: 300 yards (A 1 minute blow off period will precede this match)

Match 2: 500 yards

Match 3: 600 yards

Sunday, August 14 **NRA Registered**

All matches are slow fire, 2 sighting shots + 20 shots for record in 22 minutes.

Match 4: 600 yards (A 1 minute blow off period will precede this match)

Match 5: 600 yards

Match 6: 600 yards

Match 7: Aggregate of Matches 1+2+3+4+5+6 = 120 points possible determines State Champ.

CLASSIFICATIONS: NRA Mid Range classifications will be used. Individuals will compete in one of the categories list below. If there are fewer than 5 entries in a classification/category, those

entries may be combined into the next higher classification/category until the 5 competitor minimum is satisfied. Unclassified competitors will compete as Masters.

RULES: Current NRA High-Power Rifle Rules will govern this tournament. Any safe ammunition is allowed. Tracer/Incendiary/ Armor piercing ammunition is not allowed on any CRC range.

CATAGORIES: Target Rifle includes:

Service Rifle (NRA High Power Rule 3.1)

Any Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.2)

Match Rifle (NRA High power Rule 3.3)

F-Class Rifle includes:

F-Open Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(a))

F-Target Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(b))

Palma Rifle includes:

Palma Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.3.1)

RANGE CAPACITY: 45 shooters on 3 relays.

TARGETS: NRA mid-range 300yds - MR-63/FCA, 500yds - MR-65/FCA and 600yds – MR-1/FCA

COMPETITOR DUTIES: Competitors will score and/or operate targets if not shooting. Failure to serve your assigned detail (firing, scoring, and target duties) may result in disqualification from the match.

AWARDS: There will be cash awards based on the categories list above and subject to 5-competitor per class/category. Cash awards will be given for the individual matches.

Challenge Period: The Challenge Period ends 30 minutes after posting of the results.

REGISTRATION: Just send me an email or text prior to the match and let me know you are going to participate and which **rifle category** you will shoot. We will have registration/collect fees at the range starting at **7 AM** prior to the match start at **8 AM** on the first day.

FEES: Members \$50 and Non-Members \$65. Registration is for both days. No single day registration available.

PRACTICE: Friday, August 12, 2022. Arrive at 8:30 AM. First shots at 9am.
