PRACTICE 600 any-any: Watch your email and the CRC website for 600 yard practices during the months of January – March. I will try to hold one practice per month. Weather and range availability permitting. Members are free and guests \$10.00.

LOCATION/LODGING: Colorado Rifle Club, 76099 East 96th Ave. Byers, Co 80103. The Range is located about 8 miles east of Byers on US HWY 36, then about 9 miles North on the Leader Road (52N), then one mile west on 96th Ave to the Range gate, then one mile North to the Ranges. See www.crci.org click on “Facilities” tab for map and also a list of nearby lodging in Byers and Bennett, Colorado.

ENTRY CARD: Entries will be filled out the morning of the match. You can pay the match fees at this time also. **No advanced entries are necessary again this year.**

MATCH FEE'S: **Cash only!** Fees: \$25.00 for members, nonmembers, seniors and \$15 for juniors. **Entry fees must be paid in cash.** Exact change is appreciated. Please no checks, credit cards or bit coin.

RULES: Current NRA High-Power and F- Class Rifle Rules will govern this tournament. Any safe ammunition is allowed. Tracer/Incendiary/ Armor piercing ammunition is not allowed on any CRC range.

CLASSIFICATIONS: NRA Mid Range classifications will be used. Individuals will compete in one of the categories list below. If there are fewer than 5 entries in a category, those entries may be combined into the next higher classification/category. Unclassified competitors will compete as Masters.

NEW for 2024: FACTORY RIFLE CLASS (FRC) FOR F CLASS COMPETITION

SEE ATTACHMENT FOR RULES. FRC is not a NRA sanctioned event.

COURSE OF FIRE: There will be three (3) matches of 20 shots for record with unlimited sighters in a time limit of **25 minutes**.

COMPETITOR DUTIES: Competitors will score and/or operate targets if not shooting. Failure to serve your assigned detail (firing, scoring, and target duties) may result in disqualification for that match. Also see Etarget scoring rules in the NRA High-Power Rule Book section 9, 10 and 14.

TARGETS: NRA mid-range (MR-1) for the 600 yard matches, F Class targets are used for F Class.

WEATHER CANCELLATION: Should weather be a factor, competitors will be notified by email NLT 2000 hours the night before a match. If I don't have your email address, I can't communicate information to you. Also check the CRC website for cancellations.

AWARDS: There will be no awards at the monthly matches. The Club Championship will be determined by the aggregate of 3 out of 4 matches. This means you can throw out the lowest score or miss one match. Medals and cash awards will be given after the July match at the CRC Club House.
