

## **2025 Colorado Rifle Club 600 yard Mid-Range Prone matches**

**(NRA Approved)**

**DATES:** *Saturday April 12, Saturday May 18, Saturday June 7 (part of RTB), Saturday August 16, Sunday September 28.*

**TIME** Squadding will open at 7:30 am. Squadding closes with first shots downrange at 8:30 am.

**WAIVER:** All non-member competitors and guests **MUST** complete the CRC WAIVER before arriving at the match. The waiver can be found and completed on the CRC webpage linked [here](#).

**LOCATION/LODGING:** Colorado Rifle Club, 76099 East 96th Ave. Byers, Co 80103. The range is located by traveling 8 miles east of Byers on US HWY 36, then north about 9 miles on the Rector Leader Road (52N), 1 mile west on 96th Ave to the range gate, then one mile north to the ranges. See [www.crci.org](http://www.crci.org) click on "Facilities" tab for a map and list of available lodging in Byers and Bennett, Colorado. RV camping sites are available on the range, there is a suggested \$10.00 per day donation for electrical hookup.

**ENTRY CARD:** Entry forms will be filled out on the morning of the match along with payment of fees. **Advanced entries are not necessary. However, an email to the match director indicating your intention to attend will be greatly appreciated.**

**MATCH FEE'S:** **Cash only!** Fees: \$25.00 for members, nonmembers, and seniors. \$15:00 for juniors. **Entry fees must be paid in cash,** exact change is appreciated

**RULES:** Current NRA High-Power Rifle Rules will govern these matches. Any safe ammunition is allowed. Tracer/Incendiary/armor piercing ammunition are not allowed on CRC ranges.

**CLASSIFICATIONS:** NRA mid-range classifications will be used. Individuals will compete in one of the categories listed below. If there are fewer than 5 entrants in a category, those entries may be combined into the next higher classification/category. Unclassified competitors will compete as Masters.

**CATEGORIES: Target Rifle includes:**

Service Rifle (NRA High Power Rule 3.1)

Any Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.2)

Match Rifle (NRA High power Rule 3.3)

**F-Class Rifle includes:**

F-Open Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(a))

F-Target Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.4(b))

**Palma Rifle includes:**

Palma Rifle (NRA High Power Rifle Rule 3.3.1.)

**COURSE OF FIRE:** There will be three (3) matches of 20 shots for record at 600 yards. **Unlimited sighters** are available in each match fired in a total time limit of **25 minutes**.

**COMPETITOR DUTIES:** Competitors will score and may need to operate targets when necessary. Failure to perform your assigned duties (firing, scoring, or target pulling) may result in disqualification for that match. See also NRA Electronic Target Scoring Rules.

**TARGETS:** NRA mid-range (MR-1) for Target and Palma Rifles F Class mid-range targets (MR-1FC) will be used for F Class.

***ETargets are preferred and will be used to the extent possible. Bring an electronic device that can connect wirelessly to the Shotmarker scoring system. (i.e. iPhone, iPad, Android tab)***

**WEATHER CANCELLATION:** Should weather be a factor, competitors will be notified by email no later than 20 hours before a match. If I do not have your email address, I cannot communicate with you. Also check the CRC website for cancellations.

**AWARDS:** Awards will be determined according to rifle category and classification where there are sufficient entries per category/class.
