



KING OF THE ROCKIES
2026 COLORADO RIFLE SILHOUETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS
HIGHPOWER AND SMALLBORE

Location: Colorado Rifle Club, 76099 E 96th Ave, Byers CO 80103

Dates: SEPTEMBER 5 & 6, 2026

Eligibility: Open to all residents and non-residents.

We will shoot one match each of; High Power Rifle, Hunter High Power Rifle, Smallbore Rifle, Hunter Smallbore Rifle. Each Match will consist of 60 shots (15 per animal) (240 total).

Limited to 36 Smallbore & 24 High Power shooters

Rules: Current NRA rules will govern except where listed in the program. This will be an NRA Registered Tournament.

HIGH POWER RIFLE (ALSO HUNTER): High Power animals are in banks of 10. Relay 1 will fire 2 – 5 round sets. Targets will then be reset. Relay 1 will then shoot their last five of that animal. Relay 2 will shoot their first set of 5 on the remaining 5 animals. Then targets will be reset and Relay 2 will shoot their remaining 10, etc.

Protests: A fee of \$20 per protest will be charged. If the protest is found to be legitimate by the jury, the protest fee will be returned.

Jury: A jury of three persons will be selected and they will act as the final authority on protests or disputes concerning procedures, equipment, or other controversies.

Certification of Rifles: All rifles will be inspected and verified before the match. The range will be open on Friday, August 29th from 9:30 am to sunset for setup and practice.

Entry Fees: VENMO, ZELLE, Personal checks or cash will be accepted as payment for fees. Make checks payable to John Hood. (If paying by VENMO or ZELLE, contact John Hood for payment info)

- All 4 matches (High Power Std & Hunter / Smallbore Std & Hunter) \$110.00
- High Power **or** Smallbore (Std **&** Hunter) (2 guns) \$75.00
- 1 High Power **or** Smallbore (Std **OR** Hunter) (if room) (1 gun) \$40.00

ADDITIONAL: All competitors, as part of their entry fee **are required** to bring a “Worthy” door prize. This is not a “White Elephant” gift exchange. Each competitor’s name will be drawn, they will bring their Door Prize to the front. They will then draw another competitor’s name to give their door prize to.

Pre-registration is required by August 1st,

- **Cancellations:** Full refunds will be given for notifications 30 days prior to August 30th. 50% refund if notification occurs 2 weeks prior to match.

Squadding: Preference will be given to advanced entrants.

Saturday, September 5, 2026:

- **Smallbore Rifle:**
 - Match #1: 8:30am start (60 shot match / 15 per animal).
- **High Power Rifle:**
 - Match #2: 30 minutes after Smallbore Match #1 ends. (60 shot match / 15 per animal).

Sunday, September 6, 2026:

- **Smallbore Hunting Rifle:**
 - Match #3: 8:30am start (60 shot match / 15 per animal).
- **High Power Hunting Rifle:**
 - Match #4: 30 minutes after Smallbore Hunter Match #3 ends. (60 shot match / 15 per animal).

Awards: Awards will be given for the following:

- **KING OF THE ROCKIES:** Highest total combined score for all matches shot (240 possible).
- **HIGH POWER AGGREGATE CHAMPION:** (Standard & Hunter Combined – 120 possible)
- **SMALLBORE AGGREGATE CHAMPION:** (Standard & Hunter Combined – 120 possible)
- **Match Winner:** For each Rifle Type
- **Match 1st place:** For each rifle type, for each class.
- **Match 2nd place:** For each rifle type for each class (min 6 shooters).
- **Match 3rd place:** For each rifle type for each class (min 9 shooters).

- **AGGREGATE Category Awards:** High Women, High Senior, High Super Senior and High Junior provided there are at least three shooters in that category.

- **Pins:**
 - 5 in a row pins will be given when earned for B, A, AA classified shooters.
 - 10 & 15 in a row pins will be given when earned for B, A, AA, AAA & M classified shooters.

Classification: The NRA classification system will be used.

Ties: Ties will be broken by a one shot shoot off for each match / per class. For the aggregate awards and for the championship, a five shot shoot off will be used to determine a winner.

Long Runs: Will be fired at the end of the daily matches, and after any shoot offs.

Scoring: Competitors will score the relay following the one in which they shoot.

Match Bulletin: Each competitor will receive a final match bulletin.

Safety: Bolts and or action must be open except on the firing line after the ready command is given. There will be no handling and or adjustments of rifles in the rifle racks. All handling and adjustments with be done on the firing line. When bringing rifles to, or away from the firing line, muzzles must be pointed up in a safe direction. Everyone is required to wear eye and ear protection. **Open bolt indicators and safety glasses will be required.** The match directors and or the jury shall have the right to bar or disqualify any rifle or competitor for reasons of safety and or unruly conduct.

Target Setters: Target setters will be provided.

Smoking: Smoking is not allowed within 50 yds of the firing line.

Camping: Camping is allowed on the property and electrical hookups are available for \$5.00 / night. Free primitive camping on the Silhouette Range with outhouses. Water is available at the CRC Ranch House.

Bunkhouse: Access to the CRC Ranch House (Bunkhouse) is available through first come / first served reservations to John Hood with paid registration / entry.

FUN MATCHES: We will have optional fun matches after each of the official matches are concluded (pending time and weather).

BBQ LUNCH & DINNER: Basic bbq lunch consisting of grilled brats and chips will be provided between the Smallbore and High Power matches both days. BBQ dinner (hamburgers, etc.) will be provided Saturday evening after the High Power match. This will coincide with the Saturday Awards and Door Prizes.
