FIRST RESPONDER REMINDER

By Wayne Harris, CRC President The Colorado Rifle Club currently waives the requirement for Work Bond (WB) for First Responders, Law Enforcement officers, and people living over 150 miles from the CRC facility. First responders can just email a photocopy of their current ID to Bookkeeper@crci.org. Members living out of state or over 150 miles from the club can send proof of residency such as

This information needs to be sent to us during the fourth quarter of every year and before December 15. Then next year you can still notify us if you receive a WB payment request with your yearly due's notification that is sent out in January, February, and March. After providing us the proper information we will waive the WB requirement and it will then be reflected on the next dues notice. If we do not get a request for a WB Waiver by the end of February, you will either need to pay the WB or be made inactive on April 1.

We now have over 2,000 active members and need to follow this requirement. In future years after 2025 we will not waive the WB requirement if it is not requested before December 15.

Remember that you are EXEMPT from WB if you are over 65 years old or Permanently Disabled. If you are EXCUSED from WB requirements you need to make a request during the fourth quarter of every year for waiving the WB requirement.

The Colorado Rifle Club reached our membership cap of 2,000 active members on July 25, 2024. At that time the membership application form was taken down and a Wait List option appeared. To date we have some 66 people signed up on our Wait List with a maximum number of 300 people to be listed.

We normally lose due to attrition some 5% to 7% of our membership each year. These people drop their membership due to moving, age, or changes of interest.

Next year we will finalize our active membership roll on April 1. We currently plan on notifying the first 100 people on our Wait list the first part of January with Orientation taking place in January, February, and March before the shooting season gets under way.

KING OF THE ROCKIES RIFLE SILHOUETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS

We held our 2nd annual "King of the Rockies Rifle Silhouette Championships" this past Labor Day weekend. We had shooters from Colorado, Wyoming, and South Dakota. A special thanks to members and participants: Bob McAlice, Scott Dahms, Michael Ehr, Steve Hawks, Jeff Block, Bob & Geri Snyder, Kaz Tylicki, and Wes Underwood. Their assistance made the match a huge success. They also all shot very well. We also had several members assist with re-setting targets. This enabled them to complete their work bond requirements. A big thanks to all of them for helping out.

The King of the Rockies Rifle Silhouette Championships consisted of 4, 60 shot matches. One 60 shot match for each of the following disciplines: Smallbore Standard Rifle, HighPower Standard Rifle, Smallbore Hunter Rifle, and HighPower Hunter Rifle. All rounds are fired standing - offhand (no external support). Smallbore Rifle targets range from 40 to 100 meters and HighPower Rifle targets range from 200 to 500 meters. Rifle Silhouette is a challenging, but very rewarding sport. If you haven't tried it, come out to our matches and give it a go.

In the Smallbore Standard Rifle, Chris Farwell of Colorado was the match winner. Scott Larson of South Dakota won the HighPower Standard match. Chris Farwell was again the Smallbore Hunter Rifle match winner. David Bonner of Colorado won the HighPower Hunter Rifle match. Chris Farwell won the Smallbore Rifle Aggregate. Scott Larson

won the HighPower Rifle aggregate. Geri Snyder was High Woman shooter. Scott Dahms won High Senior. And Steve Hawks won High Super Senior.




Scott Larson won the "King of the Rockies Rifle Silhouette Championships" aggregate. Congratulations to Scott.




