## EAST RANGE ELECTRICAL

Plans are in place and progress is being made on establishing electrical service to the east range. Our intent is to extend electrical power and construct a RV park similar to the existing RV park behind the Schuetzen range. We are negotiating a contract with IREA to locate the power lines. The most economical route seems to be an underground line from the gas pumping station as opposed to extending the power overhead from the current RV transformer. IREA will place a transformer south of the east range berms. We will then have power for various needs on the east range giving us the capability to host large regional and national events.

## CRP GRASS SEEDING

We have to do what is called "mid-term maintenance" on a portion of a parcel of land we have in the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). This requires us to plant some prairie grass seed on a small area between the high power and silhouette ranges to improve the grasses and habitats for wild life. We have hired a local contractor to do the seeding. We hope to have this completed in the next few weeks. There should be no impact on the ranges, but if you see some farm machinery operating, it is part of the plan.

## ARCHERY RANGE

After a summer of construction and re-construction due to floods, the 3-D archery range is now operational. With some detail work still to be done, the range and targets are in place. The walk thru targets are located just to the west of the static archery range. Thanks to Dana Scott, Steve Kingcade, and many volunteers for putting this in place.
