## **New and Special Events Early in 2013**

In addition to the regularly scheduled monthly matches, we wanted to let members know about the new and special events early this year.

- Schuetzen range and East range re-construction is ongoing.
- The annual meeting is just around the corner, on **February 16<sup>th</sup>**.
- On **February 23<sup>rd</sup>**, we will have the first IDPA test-drive match at CRC. IDPA is stage based action shooting conduce to commonly used stock pistols and revolvers. Come on out and join us for the first match.
- **March 16<sup>th</sup>** is a normal Steel Challenge match, but we will also have a NSSF Rimfire Challenge

match at the same time. Rimfire Challenge uses a .22RF handgun and rifle shot over several stages on steel targets. There is minimal movement, no holsters and no reloading. CRC was featured on Shooting Gallery in January with a course taught at CRC. This is a low cost great event for all persons of all skill levels, and especially family friendly. \$10 for Rimfire.

- **March 16 and 17** is also the weekend for Project Appleseed. This training course teaches students the fundamentals of rifle marksmanship and is a great way to introduce new shooters and nail down the basic skills. FREE for women and

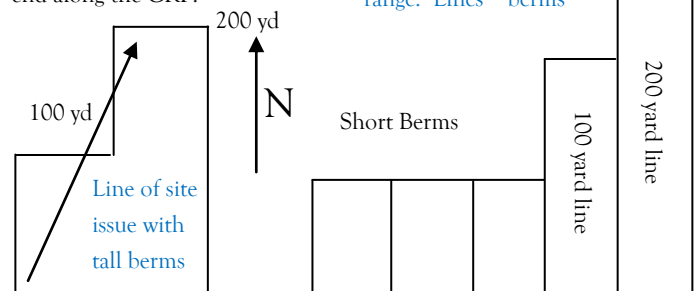


## **Range Additions and Upgrades**

The Schutzen Range should be ready for events starting in April. We were discussing some a flag system for the schutzen range. With the new design it would be possible for a shooter on the far west side of the range to not visualize a person at the 200 yard targets. Obviously, this poses some safety concerns.

nificant improvements to the east range as well. Plans include a 100 and 200 yard range on the far east end along the CRP.
